

# WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW:

- Much of the Lower Cedar Watershed is still in a severe or extreme drought despite record breaking snow falls in January.
- January temperatures are near average overall despite the unusually warm last week and the unusually cold mid-January temperatures.
- The soil hasn't frozen in most places so most of the precipitation has been able to soak in, especially in fields that have good soil infiltration like cover crop fields.

### Practical Farmers of Iowa Cover Crop Cost Share

We worked with 70 farmers to enroll 16,233 acres in the cover crop program for the fall of 2023. This signup brought \$162,330 to farmers in the Lower Cedar Watershed.



### Lower Cedar Batch and Build Update

40 structures (25 saturated buffers and 15 bioreactors) were approved by landowners. We are preparing the landowner packets now and hope to have the projects ready for the public bid process by the end of March.
